Code of Conduct

Height Gate is situated within a community of residents and should never be used for the purpose of holding a party that would involve significant numbers of people arriving at random times, loud music or excess cleaning. Please respect our neighbours and the surrounding environment.

1. Maximum group size in bunk beds is 32 internally. With some additional space for camping available, for both fire safety and facilities provided.
2. Music from the inside or outside should not be disturbing to Height Gates neighbours . Between the hours of 22:00 and 08:00 the activities of Height Gate should not be audible to our neighbours (this includes loud campfire chatter)
3. A maximum of 8 cars allowed per booking. Please make sure to park off the track either outside of the barn or in our car park 150m away. Please don't block any access needed on the track for neighbours and the farmer.
4. Please share directions sent to the the person who booked, to all guests coming to the camping barn. Make sure to double check its location.

5. The adult making the booking is responsible for any damage caused and for ensuring that the group size is known in advance and not exceeded.
6. Any damages must be reported when departing to the site coordinator.
7. One adult of the party must be appointed as responsible for safety/behavioural issues whilst your group is at Height Gate, they should make the group familiar with the safety advice provided with each booking.
8. We would expect all organised groups to have their own policies and procedures around safeguarding issues and to use these during their stay at Height Gate, and where relevant inform Height Gate's Staff. The local safeguarding plan will be shared with you before arrival.
9. Height Gate should be left in a clean condition on departure.
10. There is no rubbish collection from Height Gate, you will be responsible for removing all of your group's recycling and rubbish at the end of your stay.
11. Departure time should be no later than 12 noon, arrival time not before 14:00 unless agreed with centre coordinator.
12. No smoking anywhere inside the property.
